

WHAT TO EXPECT AT OUR COVID-19 Assessment centres

Arriving for your appointment

- If you intend on coming with a visitor who is not registered to be tested, please ask them to remain in the vehicle until you complete your visit. If you require a visitor for accessibility, translation or other reasons, only one visitor is permitted.
- Please arrive 10 minutes before your appointment to allow time for parking and accessing the Assessment Centre.
- Please ensure you wear your face mask or covering, and use the washroom prior to your appointment.
- If you require accessibility services, please inform the clerk who will notify the clinical team who can assist upon arrival.
- Free parking is available in Parking Lot A, off of Military Trail. Please print the parking permit PDF you receive upon booking. You are required to display the permit on the front dash of your vehicle while parked.
- Note that Parking Lot A is a pay-and-display parking lot that is enforced by the City of Toronto. It is important that your vehicle displays the parking permit. Toronto Police Services will look for a valid permit or a valid pay and display receipt, and they will not accept handwritten notes.
- Follow the signage for the COVID-19 Assessment Centre.
- You will be registered by one of our registration clerks, seen by the nurse and have your nasal swab completed.
- When you arrive, please clean your hands, keep mask on, practice physical distancing and present your health card at the registration desk.

After completing your test

- Clean your hands, then go directly to your vehicle or transportation. Please do not enter other areas on campus.
- Ensure you follow any instructions provided to you by the nurse regarding self-monitoring and self-isolation.
- If your symptoms become severe (difficulty breathing, chest pain/tightness/crushing sensation, feeling confused, loss of consciousness) please call 911 or visit the closest Emergency department right away.

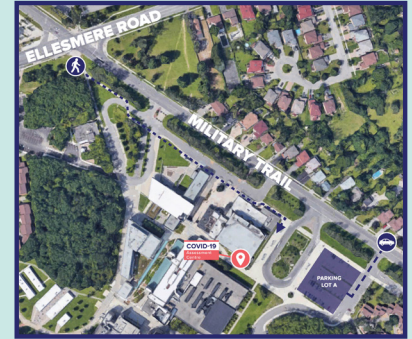

PUBLIC TRANSIT

Ride the 905 Eglinton East Express, 38/38A Highland Creek, or 95B/95E York Mills and exit at “University of Toronto Scarborough Campus” Bus Loop.



WALKING

If walking from Ellesmere, follow the sidewalk along Military Trail to Highland Hall. Please do not enter other areas on campus.



PARKING

Park your car in Parking Lot A. Don't forget to print out your free parking permit to display on the front dash of your vehicle.
