

# Interventional Cardiologist

## Department of Cardiology

Across our three hospitals and eight satellite sites, Scarborough Health Network (SHN) is shaping the future of care. Our many programs and services are designed around the needs of one of Canada's most vibrant and diverse communities. We are the third largest community hospital in Ontario and are home to North America's largest nephrology program, as well as the designated cardiac care and spine centre for Scarborough and surrounding communities to the east. The regional Cardiac Care Program includes state-of-the-art imaging services (including advanced echocardiography, cardiac MRI and cardiac CT), Cardio-Oncology, interventional cardiology, interventional electrophysiology, and cardiac rehabilitation with a group of over 30 cardiologists across SHN. We are proud to be a part of the Toronto Academic Health Science Network (TAHSN) and partner with a number of universities and colleges, helping to train the next generation of health care professionals.

The percutaneous coronary intervention (PCI) program at the SHN Centenary site is the first and largest stand-alone PCI program in Ontario. We perform over 1700 PCI and 4000 diagnostic angiograms per year in two catheterization labs with access to optical coherence tomography, intravascular ultrasound and all available calcium modification tools (rotational and orbital atherectomy, intracoronary lithotripsy etc.). We are a dynamic group of 5 interventional cardiologists who have together supported one of the largest primary PCI programs in Ontario (over 600 STEMI/emergency activations per year) and have developed a robust chronic total occlusion (CTO) program focused on advancing the field and mentoring colleagues around the country. We have established a collaborative CTO training fellowship along with our other University of Toronto partners: St Michael's Hospital, Sunnybrook HSC and University Health Network. Clinical inpatient cardiology work would take place at SHN.

The successful candidate will be a dynamic individual capable of partnering with allied health professionals and administration to advance the quality of interventional cardiology care in the region. They should be highly skilled and comfortable in all forms of both emergency and complex PCI, intracoronary imaging and physiology, calcium modification tools as well as complication management. Advanced intracoronary imaging skills and CTO PCI training would be highly valued assets and there is opportunity to participate in this program with mentorship. They must be eligible for independent practice licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario, possess RCPSC certification in Internal Medicine, fellowship certification in Cardiology and have completed minimum 2 years fellowship training in percutaneous coronary intervention. Emphasis will be placed on candidates possessing strong communication skills and progressive leadership skills with experience working in multidisciplinary teams. Start date is anticipated to be July 1, 2023 but is negotiable based current educational and employment obligations.
