Department of Cardiology

Reporting to the Chief of Staff and Executive Vice President of Medical Programs, the Chief and Medical Director will be responsible for overseeing quality of cardiac care along with other program deliverables consistent with SHN's mission, vision and values.

The successful candidate will ensure cardiac program design and recruitment/resource allocation are consistent with the new SHN 5-year strategic plan to be finalized in Feb 2024. The key pillars of SHN's new 5-year strategic plan will include 1) advancing system integration/transformation; 2) fostering research and education; 3) promoting health equity and population health; 4) enhancing quality of care and patient safety; and 5) supporting people and culture.

In collaboration with the Executive Vice President of Education and Research, the Chief/Medical Director will advance academic goals of SHN and the Department of Cardiology.

The incumbent will also provide support to the Scarborough Health Network Foundation in fundraising activities and to promote a culture of philanthropy at SHN.

Applicants must hold an MD or the equivalent thereto in cardiology and be certified or eligible for certification by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada or have comparable qualifications. Candidates must hold or be eligible for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario. The successful candidate must also be eligible for an academic appointment at the University of Toronto.

All appointments are subject to an Impact Analysis and Board approval. The hospital reserves the right not to appoint anyone to this position.
