To be eligible for this position, the successful candidate must be registered or eligible for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario. Additionally, they should have their certification by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada in Internal Medicine. Emphasis will be placed on candidates with strong interpersonal and communication skills.
