Interventional Cardiologist Department of Cardiology

The percutaneous coronary intervention (PCI) program at SHN is the first and largest stand-alone PCI program in Ontario. We perform over 1700 PCI and 4000 diagnostic angiograms per year in two catheterization labs with access to optical coherence tomography, intravascular ultrasound (IVUS) and all available calcium modification tools (rotational and orbital atherectomy, intracoronary lithotripsy etc.). We are a dynamic group of 5 interventional cardiologists who have together supported one of the largest primary PCI programs in Ontario (over 600 STEMI/emergency activations per year) and have developed a robust chronic total occlusion (CTO) program focused on advancing the field and mentoring colleagues around the country. We have established a collaborative CTO training fellowship along with our University of Toronto partners: St Michael's Hospital, Sunnybrook HSC, University Health Network and Southlake Regional Health. We have been integral to the CanCTO+Complex PCI conference, and from its inaugural event in 2023 have been a live case broadcast site for challenging cases. We have a Protected PCI program utilizing Impella CP for high-risk PCI, and having done a number of cases since starting in August 2024, are also looking to expand this program to cardiogenic shock. We are a leading educational centre for IVUS and regularly host educational days for physicians and fellows across the country. In addition to the University of Toronto CTO fellow, we also assist in the training of second year fellows from Sunnybrook HSC.

Clinical inpatient cardiology work would take place at SHN. An interest and experience in managing critically ill heart failure patients would be an asset.

The successful candidate will be a dynamic individual capable of partnering with allied health professionals and administration to advance the quality of interventional cardiology care in the region. They should be highly skilled and comfortable in all forms of both emergency and complex PCI, intracoronary imaging and physiology, calcium modification tools as well as complication management. Additional skills with Mechanical Circulatory Support would be desirable, as would an interest in population-based and health economics research. An interest in education given our partnership with SAMIH is desired.

The candidate must be eligible for independent practice licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario, possess RCPSC certification in Internal Medicine, fellowship certification in Cardiology and have completed minimum 2 years fellowship training in percutaneous coronary intervention. Emphasis will be placed on candidates possessing strong communication skills and progressive leadership skills with experience working in multidisciplinary teams.
