## Non-Invasive Cardiologist Department of Cardiology

The regional Cardiac Care Program includes state-of-the-art imaging services (including advanced echocardiography, cardiac MRI and cardiac CT), Cardio-Oncology, interventional cardiology, interventional electrophysiology, and cardiac rehabilitation. The successful applicant will join a regional cardiac care program at SHN, which includes 29 cardiologists of various specialties, and currently serves a large multicultural region within the Greater Toronto Area. Clinical responsibilities will include in- and outpatient cardiology, cardiac diagnostic testing, as well as participation in heart failure clinics.

As part of SHN's vision to become Canada's leading community teaching health network, the successful applicant would be supported to obtain an adjunct-lecturer appointment with the University of Toronto, Department of Medicine to facilitate to education of medical students and residents.

The successful candidate must be eligible for independent practice licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario, possess RCPSC certification in Internal Medicine, fellowship certification in Cardiology, CCS Level 2 training and certification in Nuclear Cardiology and CCS Level 3 training and certification in Echocardiography including transesophageal echocardiography. Advanced training in either Heart Failure or Multimodality imaging (Cardiac MRI and CT) would be an asset but not a requirement. Emphasis will be placed on candidates possessing strong communication skills and progressive leadership skills with experience working in multidisciplinary teams.
