You will be responsible for providing consultation and treatment services for the hospital in general, the emergency room and the Scarborough community; and, you will have access to the emergency department, surgical wards and operating room to support the services needed. The candidate must have experience in a wide scope of Oral Surgery including facial trauma, maxillofacial reconstruction, orthognathic surgery, oral pathology, and temporomandibular joint disorders.

The successful candidates must be eligible for independent practice licensure with the Royal College of Dental Surgeons of Ontario (FRCD), and hold certification by the Royal College of Dentists of Canada (RCDC). Candidates must also maintain a practice in the Scarborough (or surrounding) area. Emphasis will be placed on candidates with experience working in a community hospital setting as well as candidates with strong communication skills.
