Experience working in a community hospital setting and strong communication skills are highly valued. Proficiency in general orthopedic trauma surgery is also critical, as we strive to maintain a regional-leading trauma program. As part of SHN's vision to become Canada's leading community teaching health network, the successful applicant would be expected to obtain academic appointment with the University of Toronto, Department of Surgery, and facilitate the education of medical students, family medicine and orthopedic surgery residents and spine surgery fellows.
