



# Otolaryngologist

## Department of Surgery

At the Scarborough Health Network (SHN), the patient experience comes first. With three hospital sites (Birchmount, Centenary and General) and five satellite sites, SHN provides a broad spectrum of health services to one of the most diverse communities in Canada. Patient services include a full-service Emergency department at each site, advanced maternal and neonatal care in state-of-the-art birthing centres, and specialized adult and paediatric care. In addition, SHN is home to a number of regional programs serving the central east Greater Toronto Area and beyond, including cardiac care, nephrology, vascular surgery, and vision care, and is recognized as a centre of excellence in orthopaedic surgery, cancer care, and mental health.

The Department of Surgery, Division of Otolaryngology - Head and Neck Surgery, at Scarborough Health Network is seeking one otolaryngologist to join our team to be based at the Centenary Site. The successful candidate will be working with a group of 11 staff Otolaryngologists in a three-site community hospital organization committed to providing high quality, comprehensive adult and paediatric otolaryngology clinical services with 24/7 on call coverage to all three main sites. Elective OR and ambulatory outpatient clinic time will be provided. Clinical practice will be otherwise based outside of the hospital.

The successful candidate must be registered or eligible for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario and have successfully completed a fellowship in Otolaryngology with the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada. Advanced fellowship training in otology would be considered an asset.

Emphasis will be placed on candidates with experience and interest in working in a community teaching hospital setting. As an associate member of the Toronto Academic Health Science Network (TAHSN), SHN's vision is to become Canada's leading community teaching health network and transforming the health care experience for Scarborough. In 2024, Scarborough will become the newest University of Toronto academy of medicine as the Scarborough Academy of Medicine and Integrated Health (SAMIH). The successful candidate will be expected to apply for an academic appointment in the Temerty Faculty of Medicine, University of Toronto.
