## **Electrophysiologist** Department of Cardiology

The Electrophysiologist will join the Regional Cardiac Care Program and Medicine team that includes physicians, nurses, allied health professionals and administration. The successful candidate will be a member of the Department of Cardiology providing 24/7 coverage at SHN on a rotational basis. As a member of the Cardiac Care Program you will participate in clinical and diagnostic service providing community cardiology care at SHN and regional services. The Electrophysiologist's specialized responsibilities will include participation in the care of cardiac arrhythmia patients along with our current three Electrophysiologists. The successful candidate must have training and advanced skills in electrophysiology techniques and complex ablations especially atrial fibrillation ablation. The principal cardiology lab responsibilities will be to undertake complex ablations and advanced device implants (Cardiac Resynchronization Therapy (CRT) devices). They will also participate in pacemaker and ICDs implantations; arrhythmia management and device clinics; and regular electrophysiologic procedures (EP), EP study and ablation. Demonstrated leadership and organizational capability would be considered an asset.

The successful candidate will be eligible for independent practice licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario and will possess Royal College certification in Cardiology and have completed a fellowship in Electrophysiology.
